This was a very large brick mansion in the Second Empire style. It is exactly symmetrical in form, a large rectangular block broken only by a slightly projecting center facade bay and a polygonal bay on each side elevation. A pair of windows with heavy drop moldings marks each of the three facade divisions. On the

side elevations the windows also have moldings on the front half of the house, but are flush with the wall to the rear of the bays. The steep mansard roof rests on a densely bracketed cornice.

Over each projecting bay there is a hipped roof.

After the acquisition of the mansion by the fraternal order in 1918, major alterations were made. A rectangular porch with square brick piers was placed across the facade. A smaller enclosed porch was added to the rear elevation. On the interior, the major change was the creation of a large meeting hall by removing bedroom and hallway partitions. It occupies the entire width of the second floor, from the front wall to a point a few feet beyond the side bays. This makes an impressive space in a rather sombre early twentieth century taste, with the walls paneled with raised molding, a raised platform around the circumference of the room, a coved ceiling cornice, and heavy dark furnishings reflecting the "Mission" style.

On the first floor the original mid-nineteenth century woodwork, with paneled doors, heavily molded casings and wide baseboards, is intact. The floors have been covered with vinyl tile, and modern hanging light fixtures installed. The original parlor mantelpiece was replaced with a brick fireplace of the same period as the porches. The usual utilitarian additions for plumbing, electricity and heating have been made.

The building stands on a corner at the intersection of two perpendicular and two diagonal streets, and faces a small triangular park. Thus the structure is an important environmental amenity and focal point on its site. At present it is threatened with acquisition under eminent domain by the Board of Education and demolition to provide a parking lot.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This handsome example of a Second Empire house converted to a fraternal lodge hall was originally built as a mid-nineteenth century merchant's residence by a man whose associates were among the most important citizens of industrial Akron.

Andrew Jackson was one of the founders of Jackson, Buchtel and Company in 1865, a lumber firm which developed large logging tracts in Michigan. His partner William Buchtel was the brother of John R. Buchtel, the founder of Buchtel College which was the fore-runner of the University of Akron. Buchtel remained with Jackson only until 1871, when he organized his own lumber company, and later became an important banker. Jackson probably built this house a few years before the earliest available record of his living at this address (1870).

Jackson was then associated with John H. Hower, the industrialist who built the great Fir Hill Second Empire mansion which is listed in the National Register of Historic Places. By 1879 Jackson also became a contractor and builder in addition to dealing in lumber, sash, doors, blinds, etc.

At the turn of the century the house was owned by John T. Johnson, general superintendant of the Cleveland Terminal and Valley Railroad and of the Akron Division of the B. & O. It was acquired from Johnson by the Akron I.O.O.F. Organized in 1845, the Akron lodge had built its own temple on Main Street in 1892. They sold that building and purchased the Jackson-Johnson house in 1918, occupying it in 1919. Among the original incorporators were A. C. Bachtel, Clerk of Common Pleas Court and I.O.O.F. Grand Master of Ohio, and James Corey, Chairman of the Republican Party of Summit County. The membership of the Odd Fellows has included the most important city officials and experts in all professions in the life of Akron. The building still serves a large number of fraternal organizations as a meeting place, and as a structure constitutes an important environmental asset to its location.


