



| 18. History and Significance Sylvester Shaw moved his family to Bath in 1831. A log cabin already stood on the property so they used it as their home. A hard-working and well-respected man, Shaw did not participate in the township's politics. By 1856 he had acquired 124 acres. He increased his holdings to 152 acres by 1874 but died the following year. By 1881 Sylvester F. Shaw held 124 acres of his father's land as well as 56 acres nearby. | | 28.
