BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: Lewis M. Tobias was born in Akron on February 29, 1916 and was a graduate of Akron Central High School. He worked for B. F. Goodrich as a photographer and a compositor for the company's print shop. In 1952, he opened Tobias Photography Studio which he and his wife Marian operated for more than 35 years. For many years he served as official photographer for the University of Akron. He and his wife traveled extensively and presented travel programs throughout the community. He was a member of the Leica Historical Society, the Summit County Historical Society, Rubber City Artists, and First Families of Ohio.

RELATED COLLECTIONS: Upon his retirement in 1985, Mr. Tobias donated 20,000 negatives to the University of Akron Archives.

SCOPE AND CONTENT: Collection includes 124 slides of various subjects pertaining to Akron and Summit County. Most are original photographs taken by Mr. Tobias; others appear to be reproduced from existing historic photographs and postcards. Few photographs are dated. These photos may have been used for a presentation about Akron given by Mr. Tobias.
