

Digital Microfilm™ Quick Start Guide

Getting Started – ProQuest Digital Microfilm is operable in both PC and Mac environments. Before getting started, check that your machine meets these minimum requirements.

Windows Operating Systems

☐Microsoft Internet Explorer Version 7 or higher

□ Mozilla Firefox Version 3 or higher (except version 3.6)

□Adobe Reader Version 7 or higher

□JavaScript must be enabled

Mac Operating Systems

☐ Mozilla Firefox Version 3 or higher

■Adobe Reader Version 9 or higher

□JavaScript must be enabled


Selecting a Title

The Digital Microfilm ™ control panel is found in the top left hand side of the screen. Click <u>Select</u> to display the list of titles your library subscribes to. Click on the **Title** you wish to view.

<u>Year:</u> After selecting the Title, the <u>Year</u> box will populate. Click on the down arrow on the right side of the <u>Year</u> box to display the available years.

<u>Month:</u> After selecting a year, the **Month** list will be populated with the months available for that year. Click on the down arrow on the right side of the **Month** box to display the months available.

<u>Day:</u> After selecting a Month, the <u>Day</u> list will be populated with the days available for that issue, year, and month. Click on the down arrow on the right side of the <u>Day</u> box to display the day list. After selecting the <u>Day</u>, Digital Microfilm[™] will open to page 1 of the issue selected.



User Interface

1. Control Panel


- Title
- Date
- Image Adjustment
- Scroll through the reel 1, 10, or 50 images at time

2. Main Display and Toolbar

- · Zoom in or zoom out
- Print the selected page or a portion of the selected page.
- Save the selected page as a PDF
- · Email the selected page


3. Thumbnail Display

- Navigate within the microfilm reel using the scrolling controls at the bottom of the Control Panel.
- Select multiple pages for viewing and printing.
- Select a portion of an image for viewing or printing.



Scroll Commands

- Scroll Thumbnails: This function moves the microfilm image continuously while the mouse button is held depressed on either the right or left arrows.
- 2. 1 Image at time: This function moves the microfilm image to the next adjacent page.
- **3. 10 Images at a Time:** This function moves the microfilm image 10 pages from the current position.
- **4. 50 Images at a Time**: This function moves the microfilm image 50 pages from the current position.




Grayscale Image Enhancement

ProQuest Digital Microfilm[™] features grayscale image adjustment for the viewing of charts, graphs, photos, and other visual material or to improve the readability of selected text.

1. Using the <u>Image Adjustment</u> controls found on the **Control Panel** users can adjusted the brightness and contrast of the newspaper.

Drag sliders then click Adjust Image

2. Once the adjustments are made click
