SCOPE AND CONTENT: This collection primarily consists of various ledger books, journals, and record books from 1917 to 1946. Some items are in German and some are in both German and English. Also included are various plaques, framed proclamations and other memorabilia.

In English and German. Ledger of expenses, 1930-31.
4. Ledger.
In English and German, May 1, 1931 to May 1, 1932. Anton Fogler in ink on front outside cover. Includes list of members and their addresses in front of book.
5. Record.
In German, 1927-43. Expenses and other disbursements. Some pages are stamped German-American Mutual Aid Society. Also included are loose items such as financial statements, which are in binder #5A.
6. Journal.
In German, December 20, 1925 to December 13, 1926.

7. Ledger.
May, 1928 to May, 1930. Includes lists of names and addresses of people who paid for stock of the G. H. Home Co.
8. Journal.
May, 1929 to June, 1930. Includes names of individuals or businesses paid and amounts. Last page of book, 296, is headed Guest Registration February 3, 1946. Some names continued on page 294.
9. Journal.
In German and English, 1927, 1928, 1929, and 1930. Names and addresses, payments of persons who bought shares, and lists of accounts paid and amounts.
