

3. History and Significance Manville Thorp bought the land on which this house stands in 1834. He moved his family to the unimproved farm that year. By 1874 he owned 275 acres. At that time his home stood elsewhere on the property. Between 1874 and 1891 the property was divided. R. Shaw acquired land on which the house is and may have built it. The house is one of the better stick Description of Environment and Outbuildings style structures in Bath Township.
