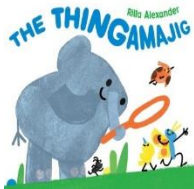


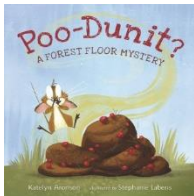

Picture Books:



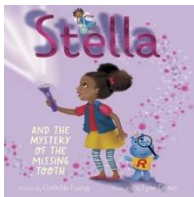
Alexander, Rilla. **The Thingamajig**, 2024. JE

Aronson, Katelyn. **Poo-dunit?: A Forest Floor Mystery**, 2022, JE.

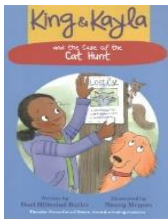
Sniff, sniff went Mouse. Whiff, whiff went Mouse. Who left this poo outside my house? I must undo this mystery. Poo-dunit?



Ewing, Clothilde. **Stella and the Mystery of the Missing Tooth**, 2023. JE

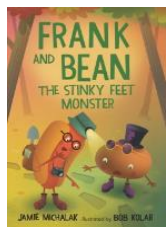
When Stella's friend Owen loses a tooth at the museum, Stella and Roger believe that someone stole it and search high and low to find it.

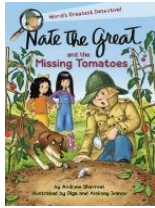
Butler, Dori Hillestad. **King & Kayla and the Case of the Cat Hunt**, 2023. JRDR

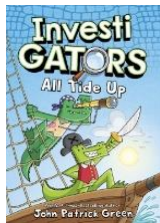


Sharmat, Andrew. **Nate the Great and the Missing Tomatoes**, 2022. JRDR

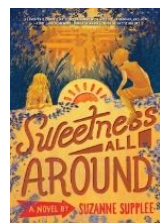
Cook, Katie. **The Never Girls: Mystery at Mermaid Lagoon**, 2023. JGN

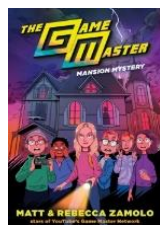
Green, John Patrick. **Investigators: All Tide Up**, 2023. JGN
